LOCATION: Knights of Columbus Hall, 10 Meadow Road, Spencer, MA

TIME: Hall will open at 8 AM. Judging will begin promptly at 9 AM.

<u>FEES</u>: \$50 per entrant; if ALSO entered in either NEMHC **OR** NEPC, \$70; if entered in all THREE, cost is \$90. Nancy Timm will be collecting all entry forms and entry fees, but will not be involved with any of the planning of FPL.

REGISTRATION: Please include the receipt form (enclosed). Entries must be received by May 26th, 2018. Entries received after this date will be charged a \$10.00 late charge fee. PLEASE make checks payable to and send entry form and fees to: Nancy F. Timm, 965-6 Main Street, Bryant Cove, Holden MA 01520. Sorry – No PayPal. We will only accept the first 50 entries each day, so first come, first served. There will be no exceptions due to the limited space in the hall, and we want everyone who comes to be comfortable. We will also not be able to accommodate those entrants who want to enter on the day of the show. <u>PROXIES:</u> For those entrants who are unable to attend, they can have their horses proxy shown. Cost is \$5.00 base fee plus \$3.00 per horse up to 10 horses for halter entries only. The person who is proxy showing must be a paid entrant to the show in which the proxied horses are being shown. This entrant will need to fit the proxied horses on his/her table and will not get a full table unless it is requested and paid for. Performance proxy is \$25 if no extra table space is needed.

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: You will need to turn in your list of horses and their exhibitor numbers, preferably printed from the Region 10 Tag Manager Program, to the show coordinator prior to the start of the show. Please be sure it is legible and that it includes every horse you plan to show. Also, double-check the horses' numbers that there are no two horses assigned the same number.

Please note, judging assignments may change on the day of the show as needed to allow the show to move smoothly and efficiently**

AWARDS: Satin flats first through tenth in each class. Custom rosettes to Champion and Reserve in English, Western, and Other Performance divisions. Custom rosettes and a custom "Pony Transportation Device (PTD)" to Overall Grand and Reserve Grand Champion in the performance division. Custom rosettes to Top Ten in Breed and Collectability/Workmanship in all halter divisions. Custom rosettes and "PTDs" to Champion and Reserve Champions in all halter divisions. Special awards to the top three entries in the OCD Challenge (see Fun Classes).

The first place winner in each class will receive a special item. The shower that collects the most items will win a special prize! There will be separate awards for performance, breed halter and collectibility halter (combined across halter divisions).

<u>LIMITS</u>: Performance – 2 horses per entrant

OF Plastic Halter classes – 3 horses per class (NO "BUY IN")

OF China classes - 3 horses per class, \$1.00 buy in for up to two additional models per class

<u>NAMHSA membership</u>: FPL 2018 has received NAMHSA membership! Horses that win a first or second place will receive a NAN card which can be used for NAN 2019-2022 or NAMHSA Merit Awards. Please be advised: NAN® is for model **HORSES** and **OTHER EQUINES ONLY.** Animals other than equines will not receive NAN tickets. Fun classes held during lunch break are also not eligible for NAN®.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

FPL is also a qualifier for The Region X Championship (TRXC). See www.regionxnation.com for more information.

There is a ribbon-recycling program. Please turn in any unwanted ribbons to the show coordinator at the end of the show. This will also help to keep future show costs low.

<u>TABLE SPACE</u> is limited. Each entrant will have half of a large banquet table to set up, so please plan accordingly. FULL TABLES may be requested on entry form. Along with your request, you must include a \$15 full table fee along with your entry fee. Several days before the show, we will see if we can accommodate those requests and notify the entrants. It will be on a "first come, first served" basis, so the entrants whose entries included the extra fee will be given first priority by date of receipt. Those entrants who cannot be accommodated a full table will be refunded the \$15.00/\$30.00 on the day of the show.

<u>LEG TAGS</u>: You will need to provide your own leg tags. This show uses the Region X tag system. Please go to this website: https://regionxnation.com/start to obtain a shower number and create/print your horse list.

You will need to turn in a list of entered horses with their corresponding numbers prior to the start of the show.

RESULTS: Full results will be posted at www.RegionXNation.com

<u>CLASSES</u>: All halter classes are <u>double-judged</u> for breed and collectability! Multiple tables will be used to save time. As one class is being judged, the next will be setting up. In performance, a timer will be used and 10 minutes will be allowed between classes for tack changes, etc. **Please** remember that performance and halter classes will be running concurrently. Please plan accordingly.

Classes may be split or combined if the number of entries warrant. If there are too few entries in a particular class, the judge may decide to combine it with another similar class in order to warrant NAN qualification.

<u>CHAMPIONSHIPS:</u> Top Tens and championships will be determined by call backs. All first and second placed horses will be called back with the ribbons won.

<u>LUNCH:</u> There will be a lunch break around noon (approximately one hour). We will have Subway come around 10 am to take orders from those interested. There are several other fast food places nearby if you do not like/want Subway. Fun classes will be held during the lunch break.

<u>RULES</u>: No radios, pets, or smoking will be allowed in the show hall. Bad sportsmanship and poor conduct will not be tolerated, and may be cause for dismissal from the show hall. The decision of all judges is final. If you have questions regarding your entry, please speak to the judge immediately after the class is pinned, while the judge's memory is still fresh. The show coordinator, judges, and the hall cannot be held responsible for any loss, damage, theft or injury to participants, their property, or their guests.

<u>RAFFLE</u>: Any and all donations are welcome!! Nice OF models, custom models, gift certificates, obstacles, live show quality tack, etc will be greatly appreciated. If you have anything you would like to donate, please tell the show coordinator when you send in your entry.

<u>FUN CLASSES</u>: As is the FPL tradition, we will once again offer the **OBSESSIVE COLLECTOR'S DISEASE (OCD) CHALLENGE!** This is a special collector's class open to collections of 8 or more of the <u>same mold</u>. Please plan for prompt set up & tear down of your collector's class as these must be set up, viewed, judged & torn back down within the lunch break. **Fun classes are non-NAN qualifying.**
