Proxy Showing

Proxy showing is available for a \$5.00 registration fee and \$2.00 per horse up to 17 horses. More than 17 horses may be show for the full entry fee.

Open Division entry fee includes all Open Divisions *per show*. Lunch will be available to purchase on premises (food truck) if desired, or there are fast food restaurants nearby. Please bring your own

tablecloth. Donations: Any donations for door prizes or raffles are gratefully accepted. These are a benefit for 4H. Awards: Printed cards in

all classes 1st-6th, 2 layered ribbons for Champions and reserves, rosettes for all top fives and grand and reserves. Only 1st and 2nd place results will be available, please keep track of all your other placings. Entries that place either first or second at this show will be eligible to compete at the next TRXC. Halter Class Guidelines

Entrants may show up to three horses per halter class with open fee. Additional horses may be entered for \$1.00 per horse. Place the horse and the dollar on the table.

- 1. Halters are optional for breed classes. If you do use a halter, be sure it is correct for the breed and fits the model correctly.
- 2. One breed class per horse plus workmanship or collectability.
- 3. Short paragraphs and reference photos are encouraged for rare breeds. Size not to exceed 8 ½ x 11 inches. Please do not place books or technology on the table (print out at home). No boxes (however you may place a photo of the box with model with your information). For collectability information MUST be provided.

Original Finish – is defined as any model that is mass-produced at a factory (i.e. Breyer, Stone, Hartland) and has not been altered in any way after leaving the factory. This includes but is not limited to the use of spray polish, applying black polish to hooves, or adding a glossy finish to a matte model. Touch-ups are permitted if not obvious.

Custom Models – are defined as any model that has been changed from its original form in any media. These classes also include models made by hand.

Artist Resins – are defined as any model, regardless of number in run, which has been home or professionally cast. Original Sculptures also qualify for the resin division. Resins that have been altered after casting still enter the resin classes.

OF China – any factory produced china, porcelain, or cold-cast porcelain show in the china division. This includes Hagen –Renaker, Japan chinas, OF Breyer porcelains, North Lights, Border Fine Arts, the Starlite Collection, and H&H Winner's Circle OF Resin Line

PERFORMANCE CLASS GUIDELINES

Entrants may show up to two setups per performance class with open entry fee. For any set-up with more than one horse – tag only ONE horse. This horse will be listed in the results and will be the horse to earn the NAN qualification. The remaining horses are considered props.

All classes (except pleasure classes) MUST have a card explaining what the model is doing. If there is no card with the entry, it will not be judged.

- 1. Riders/handlers are optional
- 2. Do not use any solid backgrounds. The horse must be visible from all sides.
- 3. Calf/animal is required for any stock work.
- 4. Cart and driver are optional for harness.
- 5. State level and movement for dressage.
- 6. State type of outfit for costume

TAGS

Finger Lakes Spring Fling/ NY Breeders will be using the Region 10 Tag Manager system to track entrant horses and generate results. Please visit RegionX website_to enter your horse list. You can also use the system to print labels for your tags. Horses MUST be entered into the system prior to the start of the show. I will be using this system to generate the results for the show.

Each shower is responsible for creating their own tags. Avery tags #11062 or equivalent (1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " to 1 $\frac{3}{32}$ " in size) white and stringed should be used. These can be found at any office supply store.

HORSE LIST

Please turn in your horse list made on the Region Ten Tag Manager on the day of the show. *Please list horses in numerical order*. The only horse list accepted is your printed out horse list from the Region Ten Tag Manager. Be sure that all horses you will be showing have been added to your horse list on the Region 10 Tag Manager BEFORE the show. You only need one list for both shows.

LODGING: There are many options including Motels, Bed and Breakfasts, and Campgrounds. **Recommend Best Western Inn, Keuka Lakeside Inn, and Vinehurst Inn and Suites, Hammondsport or Hammondsport KOA for cabins. Penn Yan hotels are another option. I do not recommend hotels in Bath except for Microtel.**

DIRECTIONS: From the west: Take the NY State Thruway (I-90E), I-86E, or 390S to I-86. Get off exit 38 in Bath and go N. on 54N. (2 hours from buffalo)

From the east: Take the NY State Thruway (I-90W to 318E. Exit 42, then pre-Emption rd. to 54S) 1 hr. 45mins. from Syracuse...3 ³/₄ hours from Albany.

From the south: From Williamsport take 15N to I-86 W to bath exit 38 and follow 54N..1 ¹/₂ hours

From the North: Take 390S to I-86s to bath exit 38 and follow 54N....1 ¹/₂ hours

If you are staying at the best western I see they have brreakfast. Just down rt. 54 to the left there is a dunkin. Go right towards the firehall and there is a kwik fill store. I will have coffee, tea, hot choc. And water at the firehall. If everyone wants to get together Fri. night I suggest the Mexican restaurants between the hotel and Dunkin. Sat. night there are tons of food options in the village at bottom of lake, turn at light.
