FEES

\$10 per Kid's division entrant. **Age 12 and under only.**

\$25 per entrant for the Novice/Intermediate division. This division is for entrants age 12 and are still novice or intermediate showers. Age 12 and under may enter this division if they have shown before.

\$50 per entrant for the Open show. Open division entrants may request a full table for \$15 in addition to the entry fee. This will be available on a "first come first serve" basis. Entrants whose request for a full table cannot be accommodated will be refunded at the show.

\$15 for lunch per person. **No outside food is allowed** by the Executive Court. Lunch can be prepaid with the entry fee. They will make exceptions for dietary restrictions.

NOTE There will be a **non-refundable** fee of \$5 for the Kid's division, \$10 for the Novice/Intermediate division, and \$20 for the Open show division. This is to cover the deposit on the show hall. Please be aware of this charge, **it is included** as part of your entry fee.

PROXY FEES

\$3 per horse up to 10 horses. If you are proxy showing and require a full table the regular entry fee applies.

SPONSORSHIP

You can sponsor a single class for \$5, a section (ex. Stone Sport Breeds) for \$15, or a whole division for \$50 (ex. OF Breyer/OM Collectability). This will cover the cost of the awards in that section and your name will be announced at the show and printed in the show booklet/class list. (It can be anonymous if you prefer).

TIME

Hall will open at 8:00 am and the show will start promptly at 9:00 am. We will break for lunch around 12:00 pm or around that time. Lunch will be approximately 30-45 minutes to keep the show moving along. We **MUST** be out of the hall by 8:00 pm, so we will try to keep classes and divisions running at a good pace. Please be aware and try to pack models as the show progresses so we can leave on time.

LUNCH

Lunch will be a deli buffet. Menu is as follows:

DEADLINE:

May 10th, 2015: Entries received after this date will be charged a \$10 late fee. ***NOTE*** Entry fee will become non-refundable on this date as well. Please be aware if for some reason you are unable to attend.

The show hall can hold up to 50-60 entrants, and it is first come, first served. If the show does not sell out, entries on the day of the show *may* be allowed. I will send out a communication on Facebook and the Region X Yahoo group if that is the case.

Please indicate which divisions you are entering to ensure you will be seated near the appropriate ring(s). You will need to turn in your list of horses and their exhibitor numbers, preferably printed from the Region 10 Tag Manager Program, to the show coordinator prior to the start of the show. Please be sure it is legible and that it includes every horse you plan to show. Also, double-check the horses' numbers that there are no two horses assigned the same number. This will prevent inaccurate results. Please read the section regarding tags and entries. Please register early to ensure your spot in the show.

Kid's Division: Custom ribbons for 1st through 6th place. Custom rosettes will be given for champion and reserve champion. (Prizes may change depending on amount of entries).

Novice/Intermediate Division: Custom ribbons from 1st through 6th place. Custom rosettes for champion, reserve champion, and top five overall. (Prizes may change depending on amount of entries).

Open Division: Custom ribbons 1st through 6th place. Custom rosettes for champion, reserve champion per group, top five overall and grand championship. Trophies will also be awarded to grand and reserve grand champion in each division.

BREYER LIVE SHOW BENEFIT PROGRAM

MMM has been selected to be part of Breyer's Live Show Benefit Program. We will be receiving the special Limited Run model "Razzmatazz" and a Glossy Classic "Amelia" to be given out as door prizes at the show! There will also be special Breyer buttons given to every entrant. I am very excited that MMM was picked to be part of this program!

VENDOR

Golden Oak Stables has agreed to be our Breyer vendor/dealer for the show! They will have models available to buy at the show. They will also be providing free T-Shirts for our paid entrants, and offering some models as door prizes. LIMITS

There is no limit on the amount of models entrants maybe bring, but each entrant will have half of a 6 foot banquet table to set up. Please plan accordingly.

The Kid's and Novice/Intermediate division entrants are limited to three models per halter/fun class and two entries per performance class.

Open division entrants have no limit on the total number of models. Open OF Plastic (Breyer and Stone) entrants are limited to **two** models per class with a maximum buy in of up to **one** model per class. **Three models total.** All other Open halter classes are limited to three models per entrant with an unlimited buy in. (The Open division buy in is \$1 per model. Please place the dollar on the show table next to your model).

A horse may be shown in only **ONE** breed class. Models shown in more than one class will be disqualified.

TAGS

You will need to provide your own leg tags. Manchester Model Madness is a participant in the Region 10 Tag System. Please contact Jackie Arns-Rossi at numbers@regionxnation.com **NO EXCEPTIONS.** The list printed from the Tag Manager program is preferred so the number on the tags will match the numbers in the Tag Manager program. You need to have your models registered in the Tag Manager **BEFORE** the show. Results are recorded online during the show to save time so you must have your models registered before. If you buy a model at the show from someone, you must add that horse's name and number to your list at the hostess table and you **MUST** add it to the Tag Manager the night of the show if it wins a NAN card at the show.

GENERAL INFO

This is a NAMHSA® (North American Model Horse Shows Association®) qualifying show. Any horse placing 1st or 2nd in any Open Division **ONLY** will be eligible to show in the 2015 through 2018 NAN®. Please read the information about NAN tickets on the NAMHSA website: www.namhsa.org. Please be advised: NAN® is for model HORSES and OTHER EQUINES ONLY. Animals other than equines will not receive NAN tickets. Also, the KID'S DIVISION and NOVICE/INTERMEDIATE DIVISION are not NAN eligible divisions.

Some divisions will **not** have a separate decorator class at this show. Please make sure any of your decorators go in the appropriate breed classes. They will be judged on collectability or workmanship only. If you choose to put your decorators in breed classes for the divisions that do have decorator classes, you may do that as well. Please be aware that a model may only show in one class in this case.

NAN cards will be placed on the table with the 1st and 2nd awarded ribbons at the time the class is pinned. Please be sure to fill in the information requested on the tickets as soon as possible to ensure the proper information is retained for your records.

TRXC cards will also be placed on the table with the 1st and 2nd awarded ribbons and alongside the proper, color coordinated NAN ticket. This ticket should be filled in immediately to ensure the proper information is retained for your records. Any horse placing 1st or 2nd in any Open Division will be eligible to show at The Region X Championship show (TRXC).

There will also be a ribbon recycling program. Please turn in any unwanted ribbons or rosettes to the show coordinator at the end of the show. This will help keep costs down for future shows.

Multiple judging tables will be used to save time. As one class is being judged the setting up for the next class can be done on the other table.

Classes may be split or combined if number of entries warrant. If there are too few entries in a particular class, the judge may decide to combine it with another similar class in order to warrant first and second place winners a fair NAN qualification.

There will be a 30-45 minute break around 12:00 pm (or when it is convenient to break). Remember, **there is no outside food allowed**. There are quite a few restaurants around if you want to leave for lunch, but the lunch break will be less than an hour in order for us to get out on time at 8:00 pm.

These will need to be set up quickly as the show hall has time constraints. Please be aware and plan accordingly.

PROXY SHOWING

Proxy showing is when you are not able to attend a show in person but will be sending one or many horses with someone else. You still need to fill out and send in an entry form. Make sure to include the name of the person that will be proxy showing your horses for you. This is not optional, it is **REQUIRED** that if you are sending a model to this show via proxy you still have to register with the show or the results will not register properly. You need to be entered in the exhibitor list on the Tag Manager or anytime your number is entered it will say "This person is not an entrant". It is only \$3 per model up to ten models to enter as a proxied shower.

RULES

Breed Assignments:

Please use the NAMHSA NAN breed cross-reference list as a general reference. It is a very comprehensive list, and a great guide. It can be found here:

If you have additional questions on breeds, please ask the judge on the day of the show.

No set-ups or handlers in halter classes. Halters and bridles, if used, must be appropriate to the breed, fit well, and must be put on in a timely fashion.

Collectability entries:

If you want the collectability judge to consider your model, you must provide a 3" X 5" index card explaining why it is collectible. (ex. "Breyer SR 1 of 350 made). There are so many new models created every year that it is almost impossible for any judge to be familiar with them all.

Fragile models may be laid on a towel or a piece of felt. The judge reserves the right to pick up and inspect these models.

No radios, pets, or smoking is allowed in the show hall. Please also no small children. Bad sportsmanship and poor conduct will not be tolerated, and may be cause for dismissal of those entrants from the show hall. Please also show only your own models or those that you are proxy showing with the fees paid. The show cannot survive without the entry fees and the donations from generous people like you.

The decision of all judges is final. If you have any questions regarding your entry, address them to a judge immediately after the class is pinned, while the reasons are fresh in the judge's mind.

The show coordinator, judges, and hall cannot be held responsible for loss, damage, theft, or injuries to participants, their property, or to guests.
