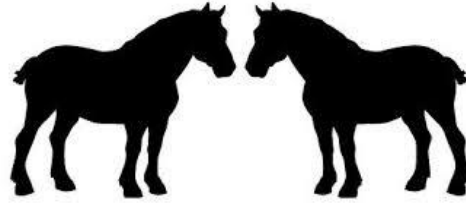

Entry Fee and Lunch Information:

Entry fee is \$65 which includes 2 free tickets* for a percheron-led carriage ride during the lunch break.

*additional tickets for the carriage ride are \$5 each

Hotel information:

The Wood Acres Farm is near route 8 and is about a 15 minute drive to I-84. The farm recommends two hotels that are within a 15 minute drive to the venue: the DoubleTree Hotel (42 Century Dr., Bristol, CT 06010) and the Courtyard by Marriott Waterbury Downtown (63 Grand Street, Waterbury, CT 06702).

Due to limited availability, **please bring your own table**. If you are absolutely in need of a table, please reach out to Joanne or make a request in the private facebook group!

NAMHSA information:

Percherons and Ponies is *pending* to be a NAMHSA member show this year. Eligible models in the open divisions, placing first or second place will receive Region X cards. For more information about eligibility requirements for NAN please visit:

All color classes in the open divisions (non-performance and non-breed classes) will be double judged for both color and collectibility. This means that one model could potentially win two ribbons in their class!

Region 10 information:

Percherons and Ponies will be using the Region X tag manager system for results. You must have a region X shower number. If you don't currently have a number, please visit <http://www.regionxnation.com/signup> Please ensure that ALL of your models are registered on the tag manager BEFORE the show. Entrants are asked to print a copy of their horse entry list to turn into the show hostess the day of the show.

All models also need to be wearing region 10 tags in order to be eligible to compete. For more information on tags please visit

Awards/callback information:

*Open classes- 1st-6th place satin flats.

*1st place and 2nd place winners will move on to sectionals. We will award a champion and reserve for each sectional winner in the performance, breed, color and collectibility categories.

*Champion and reserve sectional winners will be called back at the end of each division to be awarded an overall division champion and reserve in each divisional category: performance, breed color and collectibility.

*We will be utilizing callback rings. Please place your model on the appropriate table if they are winners.

*Please note that judges have the right to combine or cancel classes due to lack of entrants. Judges are also given the freedom to split excessively large classes if need be.

Limits:

*Entrants are allowed 2 horses per class.

Raffle:

Percherons and Ponies will be holding a raffle to help support the show. We are happy to accept any and all donations! Please inform the show hostess if you'd like to donate when signing up for the show. Raffle tickets will be \$1 each or 6 tickets for \$5.

Swap Meet Tables:

If you just want to come and participate in a swap meet, but don't want to show and pay full price for a space, you could pay a discounted sellers fee to utilize the porch space surrounding the banquet hall venue**. This is a \$10 per table fee. **Please note that this space is outdoor and is only covered by a roof and may be cold/dreary if the weather is gross that day.

There is also enough space for 2-3 sellers in the entryway to the banquet, where there are two shelves and a long entryway table that can be utilized if you want to spend a little more and be guaranteed an indoor space (with a working electric fireplace in the room too!). These are \$20 each.

Please note that table space is only guaranteed when payment is received.

Percherons and Ponies can accept checks, Venmo or Paypal.

Please bring no larger than 6' tables for showing to accommodate the size of the room/space around the room.

****Cancellation policy****

Due to the nature of this event, it is a very large financial commitment for the show holder. With that being said, thank you for understanding that we will offer refunds ***ONLY*** if we sell out and at that point are able to give your table to someone else on our waiting list. Refunds will not happen unless this occurs. If you have any questions on this please ask me **BEFORE** signing up. We love early signups, but want to make sure that there is no disappointment. We understand last minute things come up, which is why we are putting this policy in place. But if you sign up early and then need a refund shortly after, there may be a wait for us to be able to accommodate that until we sell out. Thank you.

Lunch:

*We have a big refrigerator and a long table area that can be set up for a pot luck! If you want to participate in a “family style” holiday potluck, please bring something to share! Please also let us know if you have any special dietary restrictions/allergies and you want to participate in the potluck. You can also share this information with everyone on the Facebook Ponies and Percherons participant group.

***We are planning to break for lunch from 12-1:30 so that people can go on the carriage rides that the owner Ken Wood is providing with his beautiful percherons! Two tickets are included with each show entry, or tickets are \$5 each per carriage ride! Guests are allowed to wander the property, but please remember to follow all posted rules in the barn, do not run and do not feed the horses.

Order of go:

*The show will begin promptly at 8:00 am with the all of the divisions

***The show hostess is reserving the right to change the order of go if needed.**

General information/rules

*Please remember this is all for fun. Un-sportsmanship-like behavior will NOT be tolerated and may result in us asking the individual to leave without a refund.

*In order to be considered for collectability ribbons please remember documentation!

*Use your discretion when considering models who are eligible for the breed division and their double-judged divisions (color and collectibility), as they may only be able to compete in one division depending on overlap and timing of the show.

*Do not question a judge's placings. While it is perfectly acceptable to ask what can be done to improve your entry for next time, harassment or arguing with a judge will not be allowed. Please don't interrupt a judge while they are judging to talk or ask a question.

*No smoking in the show hall

*If you or your guests have a tablet/iPod/phone that will be playing music/videos/etc. please make sure the device has earphones so as to not disturb other entrants.

*No running in the show hall. Please remember the "if you break it, you bought it" rule is in full effect here. Don't pick up someone else's model unless you are given permission to do so by the owner.

*The show holder, judges, and farm will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, theft, or injury to entrants, personal property, or their guests.

*Entrants are responsible for their own behavior as well as any guests they bring in. All children must be kept under control and entrants will be responsible for damage if they cause any.

*Please make sure any totes/boxes/personal belongings don't block doorways or aisle ways.

*Sales from tables are allowed as long as they don't block doorways or aisle ways.

*Please remember that judges are not allowed to show in any division they are judging.

*Seating requests- We are going to be taking seating requests on a first come first serve basis. We will try to accommodate friends sitting near each other.

*Guests to the farm are free to move about the farm and are welcome to visit the barn, but all rules posted in the barn must be followed. Do not run down the barn aisles and do not feed the horses.

*Ken Wood, the owner of the farm and a longtime Breyer collector, is graciously allowing guests to view his Breyer collection room in a guided tour. Do not touch or take any of the models and do not visit the room without his presence or permission.
