

Information about the venue:

*This location used to be the Clarion Inn, now renamed to the Quality Inn and Suites
*The show hall is located in the ballroom **downstairs**. If you are staying at the hotel, there is a small flight of stairs you have to go down in order to access the hall. **HOWEVER**, you can pull your car around right to the main doors of the ballroom to unload if you would like, avoiding the steps. There will also be staff available if you need assistance moving bins. Please contact the show hostess if you have any questions regarding this.
*The area to unload horses is very small, please utilize setup Friday night if possible and move your car to the main parking lot as soon as you are done unloading.
*The hotel is giving Pumpkins and Ponies a group block rate. Please feel free to take advantage of this! Call the front desk directly and tell them you are with the group to secure your room rate.

NAMHSA information:

Pumpkins and Ponies is *pending acceptance* as a NAMHSA member show. If accepted, eligible models in the open divisions, placing first or second place will receive NAN cards and Region X cards. All classes in the open divisions will be double judged for both breed and non-breed. This means one model could potentially win two ribbons in their class!

Region 10 information:

P&P will be using the Region X tag manager system for results. You must have a region X shower number. If you don't currently have a number, please visit

<http://www.regionxnation.com/signup> Please ensure that ALL of your models are registered on the tag manager BEFORE the show. Entrants are asked to print a copy of their horse entry list to turn into the show hostess the day of the show.

Awards/callback information:

*Open classes- 1st-6th place professional business card ribbons

*1st place winners will move on to sectionals. We will award a champion and reserve for both breed and non-breed

*Champion and reserve sectional winners will be called back at the end of each division to be awarded and overall supreme champion and reserve in both breed and non-breed

*We will be utilizing callback rings. Please place your model on the appropriate table if they are winners.

*Please note that judges have the right to combine or cancel classes due to lack of entrants.

Judges are also given the freedom to split excessively large classes if need be.

Limits:

*Entrants are allowed 3 horses per class. Buy ins are allowed. Any more than 3 horses can be shown by placing a \$1 on the table next to extra horse.

Raffle:

Pumpkins and Ponies will be having a raffle to help support the show. We are happy to accept any and all donations! For anyone who donates an item, they will receive 5 free raffle tickets for other items! Please inform the show hostess if you'd like to donate. Tickets will be \$1 each or 6 tickets for \$5. If you are not going to present the day the item you want is being drawn you must arrange for someone to pick up the item for you or shipping will be at your expense.

* a free half table to show in any division they are not judging. Upgrade to a full table for judges is only \$10

* free lunch

Entry fees:

\$50 entry fee **open divisions**

\$25 entry fee **novice**

\$20 entry fee **proxy shower**. Up to 20 models allowed.

\$15 **full table upgrade** (first come, first serve basis)

\$10/person **lunch**

Table space is only guaranteed when payment is received. Pumpkins and Ponies can accept cash, check, money order, or Venmo.

Novice division

Pumpkins and Ponies will be offering a novice division. Novice division judging will begin at 9:00am. This will be geared towards those who are new to showing. It will be informative and the judge will offer helpful critiques to entrants. The halter classes are double judged for breed and non-breed standards and are NOT NAN qualifying. No NAN cards will be awarded. Region X cards will be awarded for winners in each class (tentative). Please bring questions and don't hesitate to ask for help! In the performance division and OF plastic division- these classes are open to OF plastic models only. There is also a division for custom / artist resin models that is going to be judged on workmanship standards only. Please see classlist for more information. Cross entering between novice and open divisions is not allowed.

Lunch:

If time allows, we will be taking a 15-20 minute lunch break. At this time, classes will be paused so entrants and judges can eat. If entrants chose, they may purchase lunch for \$10 per person per day. Lunch will include; subs from Wegmans (turkey, roast beef, ham, or veggie with add your own condiments), chips, drink, and a dessert. Any dietary restrictions or if a vegan/vegetarian option is needed, please inform the show hostess. Please let us know if you'd like to purchase lunch before the show so we can get an accurate count of how much we will need.

Order of go:

- *The show will begin promptly at 8am with the all of the open halter divisions
- *For performance, CM/AR division will go first, followed by OF performance.
- * Novice division judging will begin at 9am
- *The show hostess is reserving the right to change the order of go if needed.**

General information/rules

- *By entering this show you are agreeing to follow all mandates and restrictions set by the show holder in regards to COVID 19.
- *New for this year- in order to cut down on some show rings, all scales will show together in their appropriate division. It will be at the judge's discretion to divide the class by size if necessary (large amount of entries)
- *Please remember this is all for fun. Un-sportsmanship-like behavior will NOT be tolerated and may result in us asking the individual to leave without a refund.
- *In order to be considered for collectability ribbons please remember documentation!
- *Do not question a judge's placings. While it is perfectly acceptable to ask what can be done to improve your entry for next time, harassment or arguing with a judge will not be allowed. Please don't interrupt a judge while they are judging to talk or ask a question.
- *No smoking in the show hall
- *If you or your guests have a tablet/ipod/phone that will be playing music/videos/etc. please make sure the device has earphones as to not disturb other entrants.



*No running in the show hall. Please remember the “if you break it, you bought it” rule is in full effect here. Don’t pick up someone else’s model unless you are given permission to do so by the owner.

*The show holder, judges, and hotel will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, theft, or injury to entrants, personal property, or their guests.

*Entrants are responsible for their own behavior as well as any guests they bring in. All children must be kept under control and entrant will be responsible for damage if they cause any.

*Please make sure any totes/boxes/personal belongings don’t block doorways or aisle ways.

*Sales from tables are allowed as long as they don’t block doorways or aisle ways.

*Please remember that judges are not allowed to show in any division they are judging.
