Hall Access

The show hall will open at 8:00am both days, the show will begin promptly at 9:00am.

There will NOT be access to the hall Friday night.

Showers may leave items in the hall Saturday night, the hall will be locked overnight.

Novice Show

The Region X Futurity novice show will run concurrently with TRXC on Saturday. This is a completely separate show and no cross entry is allowed with TRXC. For more information please see The Region X Futurity show packet at www.RegionXNation.com.

Fees

\$60 for one day, \$120 for both days. Proxy fee is \$40 for one day, \$80 for both - Proxy showers may have up to 30 models proxied for them each day. Upgrade to full tables are available for \$20 each day (first-come-first-served, if available). Sales tables are available for the weekend, see information below.

Tags

The show will utilize the Region X Tag Manager system. You must obtain a Region X shower number to participate by going to: www.RegionXNation.com and following the links.

Each entrant must provide a printed copy of their horse list prior to the start of the show.

Registration

Online registration will open September 3, 2018. Go to www.RegionXNation.com and choose "TRXC Central" from the "Tag Manager" menu. Fees must be received by October 3, 2018. BEWARE! Artists Judging! PLEASE READ!

Because artists may not judge their own work we ask that AR and CM showers please plan your show string accordingly for showing under Morgen and Ann.

In CM/AR Performance, no artistic work by Morgen may be shown. This includes models with finishwork done by Morgen (on sculptures by her or other artists) and any models sculpted by Morgen (these include both artist resins and customs done on mass-produced bodies sculpted by Morgen).

In AR and CM halter, you may show models by either artist, but they will be not be judged by the artist that worked on them. For example, in AR Maiden Light Breed you may enter a model with finishwork by Ann, but it will be skipped over by the breed judge (Ann) and judged on workmanship only (Morgen). In the Stakes classes, models sculpted or finished by Ann may only be shown in the Workmanship Stakes and models sculpted or finished by Morgen may only show in the Breed Stakes.

Show Format and Eligibility

TRXC is championship show, so the format is a little bit different from what you may have experienced at other models shows. There are two different types of classes: Stakes and Maiden. It is very important to understand how to enter these classes so please read the following rules carefully.

Stakes Classes

The Stakes classes are the TRXC championship classes. To enter a Stakes class your model must have a qualifying card from placing 1st or 2nd in a corresponding class at a Region 10 open show in 2015, 2016, 2017, or 2018.

You will need to place the qualifying card next to your horse on the on the table when entering a Stakes class. You do not need more than one of the same qualification, i.e. one Collectibility or Workmanship, one Breed, one for the appropriate Performance class. Stewards will check the cards to confirm that your model is qualified and in the correct Stakes class.

You can find your personalized list of models qualified for TRXC by logging into your Tag Manager account at www.RegionXNation.com. Be sure to select whether you plan to compete in Open or Novice for an accurate list.

Maiden Classes

Maiden classes are open to models not currently eligible to compete in the Stakes classes. Maiden classes will be placed 1st-6th with the 1st and 2nd placed models eligible to enter the following Stakes class.

Models that have current NAN cards but not TRXC qualifications (i.e. new purchases, out of region showers, etc.) may show in the Maiden classes.

In Halter, models with breed only or workmanship/collectibility only qualifications MAY NOT show in Maiden classes, as they are already qualified.

In Performance, models may enter Maiden performance classes they are not currently qualified in, even if they have another performance qualification already. For example, if your model is qualified for western trail but not western pleasure, it may enter the Maiden Western Pleasure class, but not the Maiden Western Trail class.

Limits

Maiden Performance Classes: 2 models per class per shower

Maiden Original Finish Plastic Halter Classes: 2 models per class per shower

All Other Maiden Halter Classes: 3 models per class per shower

Important Note: No "buy ins" for additional entries will be allowed this year

Stakes Classes: Showers may show as many qualified models as they wish in the Stakes classes, but please be mindful of your own abilities to get models to the rings in a timely fashion.

NAMHSA Member Show

TRXC has been approved as a NAMHSA member show! Models placing first and second in the **Maiden classes only** will receive NAN cards and Region X cards. **Maiden classes are only open to models not currently qualified for TRXC 2018 Stakes classes.** Stakes class winners will not receive NAN cards.

Breyer Live Show Benefit Model

TRXC has been approved to receive a special run model through the Breyer Live Show Benefit program! "Vulcan" is a beautiful dapple flaxen chestnut with glossy finish done on the running stallion mold (see photos at www.breyerhorses.com/2018-live-benefit_show-info). This model will be given away on Saturday in a door-prize style random drawing. Each paid Saturday TRXC and Region X Futurity entrant will receive one ticket, no additional purchase necessary. To be eligible for the drawing you **must be showing in person on Saturday**, proxy entrants are not eligible.

Awards

Maiden classes will be pinned 1st-6th with custom business card "flat ribbons". First and second place models will receive NAN and Region X qualifier cards.

In the Stakes classes, each Champion and Reserve will receive a rosette and a blue Region X ticket that may be used toward Region X Achievement Awards. Top Honors models will receive certificates.

In Stakes classes with less than 5 entries, a Champion and Reserve Champion will be named. In Stakes classes with 5-9 entries, a Champion, Reserve Champion, and one Top Honor will be named. In Stakes classes of 10-15 entries, a Champion, Reserve Champion, and 3 Top Honors will be named. In Stakes classes of 16+ a Champion, Reserve Champion, and 5 Top Honors will be named.

The show holders reserve the right to combine or split classes depending on entry numbers to ensure fair competition.

Raffle and Silent Auction

A silent auction and benefit raffle to support the show will be held both days. Any and all donations are welcome!! Nice OF models, custom models, gift certificates, obstacles, live show quality tack, etc will be greatly appreciated. If you have anything you would like to donate, please tell the show coordinator when you send in your entry.

Show Program

Robin Briscoe has generously offered to put together a show program for TRXC. Each entrant will get one page to use as they wish, for example you could tell a little about yourself and your collection, highlight a hobby skill you may have (painting, tack making, etc), sales or hobby services ad, etc.

Please submit your page in a copy-ready format to Robin at robin_briscoe@hillspet.com before October 3rd to be included in the program.

Other Rules

No radios, pets, or smoking will be allowed in the show hall. Bad sportsmanship and poor conduct will not be tolerated, and may be cause for dismissal from the show hall. The show coordinators, judges, and venue cannot be held responsible for any loss, damage, theft or injury to participants, their property, or their guests.

Children/minor attendees must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.

The decision of all judges is final. If you have questions regarding your entry, please speak to the judge immediately after the class is pinned, while the judge's memory is still fresh.

Lunch

A boxed lunch option will be offered both days. Box lunches will cost \$14.00 and will include a sandwich, piece of fruit, chips, water bottle, and cookie. Several sandwich choices will be available. More information on this will be provided to entrants so they may pre-order before the show.

Food is also available at the Campus Center food court located one floor up from the show hall. Choices include the *Harvest Market* (snacks/beverages/take out salad and food bars) and *The Grill* and *Tamales* (Mexican) in the Blue Wall food court. See <http://umassdining.com/locations-menus/campus-center> for more information, please note that not all vendors will be open on the weekend.

If time allows, a formal lunch break will be taken, but competition may continue if needed.

Pizza Party

The traditional pizza party will take place Saturday evening after the show. Cost is \$10.00 per person and will include pizza, salad, a drink and dessert. Please note on the Registration page if you will be joining us!

The Chicopee/West Springfield area (about 25 miles from the hall) also has a large number of hotel options. There are also many small bed & breakfasts type accommodations in the area.

Please note that our October 13-14 weekend date is at the peak of western Massachusetts fall foliage season. If you plan to stay over in the area we strongly recommend making your reservations well in advance to avoid disappointment.

Parking and Getting Around Campus Center

The UMass Campus Center complex can be a bit confusing for first time visitors, so please read the following directions carefully. Unfortunately, we are not allowed to put up signs directing TRXC entrants to the Auditorium (show hall). Don't be intimidated, it sounds more confusing than it actually is once you are there!

There are two ways to bring your models into the Auditorium: through the parking garage or through the loading dock. Both ways will require you to transport your models over a bit of distance, so if you have a handcart or other wheeled conveyance you are advised to bring it along. The map shows the paths after you turn onto Campus Center Way from Commonwealth Avenue.

Parking Garage *(Green Line on Map)*

All entrants must park here during the show. There is a daily fee for parking of \$7.00.

To reach the main garage, bear left and follow the signs to Hotel UMass/Campus Center Parking. You will enter the garage on Level 3. Follow the signs to the Hotel UMass entrance on Level 2. Go in through the Hotel UMass entrance, down the corridor and into the Campus Center lobby. Continue to follow the Hotel UMass signs a short distance to the elevators. Go down one level, the Auditorium is just across from the elevator.

Loading Dock *(Yellow Line on Map)*

You may also use the Campus Center loading dock to bring your models into the show hall. The loading dock is on the same level as the Auditorium and will not be in use by other parties over the weekend.

To access the loading dock, bear right and follow the signs to Campus Center Loading Dock. The road will end at the loading dock entrance. Go up the ramp on the right and use the large garage door or small door on the right to enter the building. Go straight through two sets of double doors, then left at the main lobby. The Auditorium will be the last room on the right.

Please note you may NOT leave your car here! After unloading you MUST move your car to the main parking garage for the day.
