Introduction:

Welcome to the fourth Usquepaugh Model Horse Club Live Show! This show offers UMHC member and model points that accumulate for overall Championships at the end of the Season in August of 2027. For more information please see the UMHC Rulebook. Additionally, this show is TRXC qualifying and has applied for NAMHSA qualifying.

Note about the Show Hall:

This show hall is one story with no steps to access the hall for easy access. We will be using the community room and foyer area (the Masonic Temple area is locked and inaccessible). There is a kitchen area with a fridge to store items if need be. The bathrooms were recently remodeled – no standing on the toilets. There are security cameras at the main door and in the foyer but not in the hall itself – the front door may be locked for security during the show time (use the doorbell if need be).

Times:

The show hall will open at 8:00 am with judging starting in all rings at 9:00 am. Two rings will be used for most/all classes with one ring setting up while the other is being judged. We need to try to be done by 4:00 pm so let's keep things moving along.

Show Registration:

ALL entries MUST be made via the club website. Showers must select the table type AND the divisions being entered – there is a nominal additional fee for each division entered to defray award costs and keep track of the number of entrants in each division. The number of each type of table available is as shown on the website – once sold out, that table type option is gone. Payment is to be made on the website at time of registration. There is NO emailing to reserve a table etc. – all entries must be made and paid on the website, no exceptions.

UMHC Points & Format

All participants in UMHC shows automatically become UMHC members.
Models receive points through a system where classes are group into sub divisions (not unlike typical championships). The top 3 or 4 models (see the limit chart) in each class then go on to the Championship Qualifier for that sub-division where models are placed 1st thru 6th and awarded points. These point are cumulative over the show season (a minimum of 3 qualifier shows) - the model with the most points at the end of the season wins the Overall Champion and 2nd highest reserve.

Additionally, member that attend and/or judge receive "Member Points".

These points are tracked by the UMHC Board and the shower does not need to track the results or save cards for UMHC championships.

ALL horses showing MUST be entered into the system prior to show!!

NAMHSA:

This show has applied to be a NAMHSA (North American Model Horse Shows Association) qualifying show for NON CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER CLASSES. Any horse placing 1st or 2nd in qualifying classes ONLY will receive a "NAN Card" be eligible to show in NAN. For more information about this, please refer to the NAMHSA website: www.namhsa.org Please note that NAN is for HORSES and OTHER EQUINES only – other animals will not receive NAN cards. See Class Color Codes to identify NAN qualifying classes.

Class Color Codes:

The class list has class names/numbers shown in different colors. These colors signify the types of qualifications for those classes:

Black – UMHC qualifier, TRXC Cards

Blue – NAN Cards, UMHC qualifier, TRXC Cards

Red – UMHC Points

Green – UMHC qualifier, Novice TRXC Cards

Open Masters vs. Open Casual:

Showers should self-select the appropriate division for themselves and their showing goals. Open Masters offers NAN cards and is intended for folks that often win championships and attend or may attend NAN. Open Casual offers a space for folks that are often middle-of-the pack at shows and are showing to challenge themselves and for fun. For example, I would be a Casual Open shower – I am not a Novice because I have open shown for decades, but I don't have the time/money/skills to compete and win in highly competitive classes – I show all my own tack and props and am happy to compete and see how I do. The Open Casual division gives folks like me a place to show on a more even playing field.

Raffle:

There will be a raffle at this show – any donations are welcome. 100% of the proceeds from the show season (beyond expenses) benefit the show's charity.

Lunch:

Every attempt will be made to have a 30 minute lunch break around noon unless classes are running very behind. A "Lunch, Snacks, and Drinks" package may be pre-ordered on the website prior to the show for \$8. See the website for details.

Hotels:

There are no hotels in the immediate area of the show hall, but most national chains are within 20 minutes. Given the car theft at TRXC in 2023 I do not recommend staying at any hotels near TF Green Airport.

Holiday Inn South Kingstown– south about 15 minutes – can be busy (and price higher) with college parents and tourists and is fairly old, but is the closest to the show hall

Best Western West Greenwich – northwest 20 minutes right off I-95 – budget hotel

Super 8 West Greenwich/Providence northwest 20 minutes right off I-95 – very budget hotel – good luck

Hampton Inn Coventry/Warwick – northwest 25 minutes right off I-95 and in developed area – probably among the best options for a decent hotel

Holiday Inn Express Coventry West Warwick - northwest 25 minutes right off I-95 and in developed area – probably among the best options for a decent hotel

Stagecoach House Inn – southwest 25 minutes - Historic little hotel – may be pricy for what it is but is more of a B&B

General Rules:

- No set ups or handlers in halter classes. Halters and bridles, if used, must be appropriate to the breed, must fit well, and must be put on in a timely manner.
- Fragile models may be laid on a towel or piece of felt. The judge reserves the right to pick up and inspect these models.
- No radios, pets, or smoking is allowed in the show hall

- Bad sportsmanship and poor conduct will not be tolerated and may be cause for dismissal of the entrants involved from the show hall.
- Given that so many models are fragile and valuable, please be sure that children in attendance are aware that no running is allowed and good manners are required. The adult guardian of any children in attendance is ultimately responsible for their conduct – if there are issues, the children and guardian will be asked to leave.
- The decision of all judges is final.
- UMHC, the show coordinator, judges, and the hall can not be held responsible for any loss, damage, theft, or injury to participants, their property, or to guests.
